



## Technical Data - Coring and Diamond Drilling







We operate a range of rigs to provide core samples from various concrete surfaces or structures so that investigation, laboratory testing or analysis can take place.

Our trailer mounted 'Neptune Excalibur', diesel-powered rig can be used on footways, highways and areas of hard-standing (concrete or blacktop) where there is free vehicular access. The rig can be fitted with core barrels up to 300mm (12") for use in confirming pavement layer thicknesses or composition.

The rig is fitted with hydraulic outriggers to allow fast, accurate levelling when setting up to core.

We frequently conduct highway & pavement coring, often in conjunction with in-situ testing (e.g. CBR tests).

All highway works are carried out by NRSWA Streetworks qualified personnel. Any required reinstatement is undertaken according to the Specification for the Reinstatement of Openings in the Highway (SROH) procedures.

If vehicular access is not available and/or for work inside structures, we operate Hand-held, frame and tracked, barrow mounted electric (110v) rigs. These also allow horizontal and inclined coring of concrete structures. We operate a range of barrel sizes from 50-200mm, in lengths up to 500mm, with extension rods if required.
